## **Application for Landmark Designation for Historic Property**

The Ventura County Cultural Heritage Board (CHB), acting as the Oxnard Cultural Heritage Board, will consider a request to recommend the designation of a property as Ventura County Landmark No. 184 to the Oxnard City Council, in accordance with Section 1365.1 et seq. of Ventura County Ordinance No. 4604 and Resolution 10,135 of the City of Oxnard. The property is the site of Schuster Court, historically significant for its reflection of the postwar multifamily housing boom in Southern California and as an example of courtyard housing built in the Minimal Traditional architectural style. The property is located at the following address:
