Consider Point of Interest Designation for Historic Property

The Ventura County Cultural Heritage Board (CHB) will consider designation of property as Ventura County Point of Interest No. 19, in accordance with Section (1365-1) et seq. of the Ventura County Ordinance No. 4604. The property is the site of the former Piru Quonset Hut Community Center, historically important as a representative example of World War II-era prefabricated military architecture and significant for its long-standing association with community life in Piru. Likely built in the 1940s, the former Piru Quonset Hut Community Center served for decades as a gathering place for local residents and reflected the social, cultural, and architectural history of the region, including its use for celebrations, ceremonies, and community events throughout the second half of the twentieth century. The property is located at the following address:

You are hereby notified of a public hearing to be held before the CHB to review this consideration. At this hearing, there may be presentations by the applicant and the property owner with an opportunity for any interested person or authorized agent to comment on the item.

Environmental Review: This application is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15308 which is consistent with a Class 8 exemption (Actions by Regulatory Agencies for Protection of the Environment).

Notice is hereby given that the County Ordinance Code authorizes the CHB to designate the above property as a Ventura County Point of Interest once a notice is given to the property owner and a public hearing is held on the matter. The CHB is the final decision-making authority on the Point of Interest designation where the property owner has no objection.
